Course Overview

Summary	This course provides refresher training on the operational aspects of CREATE covering all controls and settings needed to build and run a job. This course is designed to enable users with previous CREATE experience to migrate to the latest version of software. It is also useful for users who have had training in the past but feel they may have gaps in their knowledge.

Objectives

At the successful completion of the course, the delegate will:

- Be familiar with the CREATE user interface.
- Understand the concepts of jobs, template pages and associated files.
- Be able to decide which graphic elements are more efficient to generate in CREATE.
- Understand all configuration options within CREATE required to build template pages.
- Be able to work in 3D space combined with the use of layers.
- Be able to use Primary Objects, Timeline and Text Animations.
- Be able to use plugins to achieve animations.
- Be able to use fields to manage data within a template.

About this Course

The purpose of this course is to refresh the knowledge of experienced graphics designers reminding them of the full range of the functionality of the CREATE software. It may well cover new functionality unfamiliar to the delegate. Some time will be available for practical exercises building on what has been learnt.
