At the successful completion of the course, the delegate will:

- Be completely familiar with all aspects of a Gallium FACTORY system.
- Understand the role, operation and architecture of the system.
- Understand the system workflow and onsite installation and configuration.
- Apply configuration changes with confidence.
- Manage software/hardware updates and installs.
- Be resourceful in troubleshooting issues, diagnosis and logging.
- Design and manage VSP and PPMC definitions and layouts.
- Manage PPMC users and access rights.
- Be familiar with the operation and control of transmission channels.

About this Course

The course focuses on customer specific installation and system workflow. This training builds on what was learnt in the Gallium FACTORY Operation course and the Gallium FACTORY Technical technical, providing delegates with sufficient knowledge to support other users, make changes to the system and to act as the principle point of contact between the customer and Pixel Power.

The course comprises a combination of classroom theory using PowerPoint presentations and software demos and practical workshops that allow users to gain hands-on experience.
